JAGGED ROCK VINEYARD

Jagged Rock Vineyard, surrounded by steep rocky cliffs at 1,400 feet elevation, is a remarkable spot. The sparse, sun scorched soils and heat reflecting off the cliffs provides an ideal viticultural environment. Each area of the vineyard has its own unique growing condition, allowing the winemakers to choose specific blocks to get the most out of the Syrah and Viognier used to create this refreshing wine.

TASTING NOTES

Floral notes complemented by dense black fruits, spice, pepper, and generous tannins.

APPELLATION | Okanagan Valley BC VQA

ELEVATION | 356m - 385m

SOILS | Deep, stone-free, formed from glacial deposits

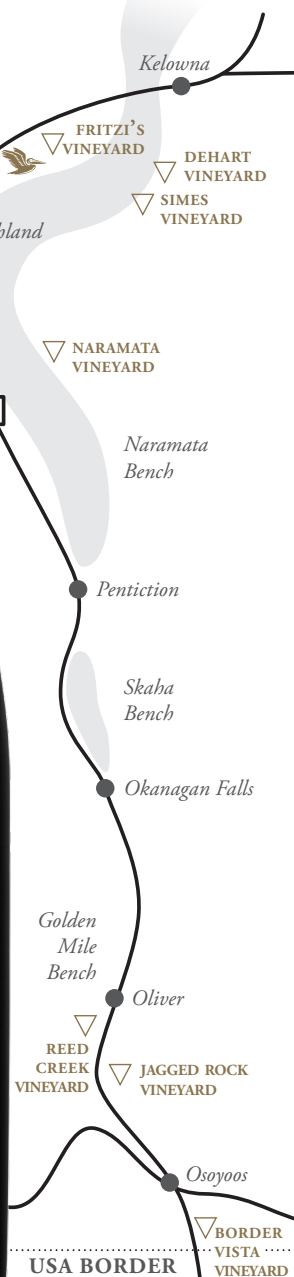
SEASONAL CONDITIONS | A cool, wet spring gave way to a warm and dry growing season that extended well into October.

VARIETIES | Syrah (97%), Viognier (3%)

CANOPY | Vertical shoot positioning; cordon spur pruned

MATURATION | 15 months in French oak barrels (60%), Foudre (16%), and puncheon (8%)

ABV | 14.5% **TA** | 6.2 g/L **PH** | 3.72
