### DEHART VINEYARD

Situated on a hill adjacent to DeHart road in East Kelowna, this vineyard is unique for its cooler climate and early ripening characteristics. As a result of higher elevation and being positioned for complete afternoon sun exposure, this vineyard produces vibrant Pinot Noirs with great finesse. This Pinot Noir is unfiltered, unfinned, and wild fermented. A very natural approach to our winemaking with this delicate and fickle grape.

### TASTING NOTES

Bright cherry and floral aromas with earthy complexity and fine tannins.

**ESTATE** | DeHart Vineyard

**ELEVATION** | 430m - 470m

**SOILS** | A millennium of glacial activity left behind a topsoil of fine silt sitting on a gravel bedrock. The silt retains water and heat, allowing the Pinot Noir on this cooler northern vineyard to fully ripen.

**SEASONAL CONDITIONS** | A warm spring and summer was followed by a cool fall, perfect for flavour development and acidity retention

**CLONE** | 777

**CANOPY** | Cane pruned with vertical shoot positioning

**MATURATION** | 14 months in French barriques

**ABV** | 13.2%   **TA** | 5.5 g/L   **PH** | 3.48
