NARAMATA RANCH VINEYARD

Naturally moderated by its close proximity to Okanagan Lake, the Naramata Ranch Vineyard also features substantial elevation changes as well as breathtaking views of the dramatic landscape. By far, this is our most climatically and geologically diverse site. Red granite rock rests on the surface above granite bedrock, with no grass or cover crop.

TASTING NOTES

Complex and textural with a fresh, persistent finish.

ESTATE | Naramata Ranch

ELEVATION | 410m - 420m

SOILS | Fine silts deposited by ancient glacial activity

SEASONAL CONDITIONS | A warm spring and summer was followed by a cool fall, perfect for flavour development and acidity retention

CLONAL SELECTION | 548 (11 year old vines) & 95 (30+ year old vines)

CANOPY | Spur pruned with vertical shoot positioning

MATURATION | Fermented and aged in barriques, puncheons, and concrete egg

ABV | 13.5% **TA** | 6.2 g/L **PH** | 3.34
