BORDER VISTA VINEYARD

Grown on a small vineyard estate in Osoyoos on the eastern side, our Border Vista Rosé, is a delightful, dry Rosé of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Syrah. The name, Brigadier's Bluff, is derived from the many fur traders, often called brigadiers, who travelled through established Okanagan Valley trails in the late 1800's. These trails passed along many bluffs that look out over the valley. Image No.19 is the estate vineyard in the early morning hours, at the break of dawn.

In the background is one of our wind machines that helps with frost protection.

TASTING NOTES

Refined yet expressive. Wild strawberry and ruby red grapefruit with an amazingly complex and seamless texture.

VARIETALS | Merlot (74%), Cabernet Franc (13%),
Syrah (13%)

ESTATE | Border Vista Vineyard, Osoyoos

ELEVATION | 330m - 360m

SOILS | Gravel-free, loamy sands with
coarse textures.

SEASONAL CONDITIONS | Warm and consistent, giving way to one
of the coolest falls on record. Perfect
conditions for natural acidity retention
and flavour development.

CLONAL SELECTION | 181, 347, 7, 327

CANOPY | Cane pruned with vertical shoot positioning

MATURATION | 25% neutral French oak, 75% stainless steel

ABV | 13.0% **TA** | 6.7 g/L **PH** | 3.04
